IMPLEMENTATION PERIOD	18 months
DESCRIPTION	The project concerned 420 families (400 for agricultural activities and 20 for herding activities), 1,300 children, 80 local promoters to follow the agricultural and nutritional aspect, 40 local promoters to follow hygiene, and 20 local planners (following agricultural, territorial, and sanitary aspects). Village families were involved in awareness campaigns related to good water resource management.
OBJECTIVES	The project improved of the living conditions of poor families in 20 villages in the Svay Leu and Banteay Srei districts, Siem Reap province, by increasing food and nutritional security and improving and diversifying agricultural production, through the supply of water for agricultural and human use.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training in agricultural production for 400 families; • Creation of at least 400 home gardens to increase food availability; • Activation of 20 family-run pig farms; • Organization of training courses in hygiene and food security; • Organization of courses for technicians, planners, and health personnel on food security and efficient water resource use; • Construction of 10 wells and rehabilitation of 20 water basins; • Distribution of 400 water filters and training for 40 workers on appropriate use of water systems (wells, water basins, water filters).
