OBJECTIVES	This project guaranteed access to water in the Hebron district, improving hygienic conditions and the quality of life of the involved populations.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction of cisterns for rain water collection and direct water distribution points in the As Samu municipality; • Construction of waterline connections in the village of Hattalin (Area C) to optimize the water distribution system, reduce leakage, and reduce the distance from water sources; • GVC and PHG organized a water quality monitoring campaign for the water present in the collection cisterns to ensure that no health risks are posed to the general populationof these rural West Bank villages.
