DESCRIPTION	The project addressed to 700 urban farmers, of which 60% women working with agro ecologic practices, natural cosmetic and vegetables, biologic fertilizers, and to a network of almost 300 agro ecologic consumers, brought benefits to the entire population of the Municipality of Rosario (almost 900.000 people). Green spaces and the natural and turistic landscape were valued and the productive model based on biological intensive production and associative dynamics were reinforced.
OBJECTIVES	The project improved the socio-economic conditions of the Municipality of Rosario's population, by reinforcing the eco-sustainable productive model and by enhancing the city's green spaces.
