DESCRIPTION	Given the prolonged nature of the Syrian crisis and the presence of high unmet needs, the project will address the critical humanitarian WASH needs of up to 15.525 of the most vulnerable Syrian and Lebanese households living in under-served districts of North Beqaa Valley in Lebanon. The project will ensure that targeted families have the right to access safe drinking water and proper sanitation, promote good hygiene, and reduce the risk of diseases related to poor access to clean water, sanitation and hygiene.
OBJECTIVES	Ensure prompt response to basic needs on WASH to Syrian and Lebanese families hosted in the target Area. Furthermore, the action is to ensure the coverage of the needs regarding access to safe water, sanitation facilities as well as water storage and promotion of safe hygiene practices.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Procurement of equipment (latrines, water tanks, other water storage materials, cleaning and hygiene kits). • Installation of 335 emergency latrines with hand washing facilities. • Distribution/installation of 193 water tanks, 1158 jerry cans , 579 buckets and improvement of 34 internal water distribution schemes. • Realize and awareness campaign focused on personal hygiene (incl. hand washing), safe water chain, diarrhoea management, food hygiene, safe waste management and safe grey water disposal.
