DESCRIPTION	The project EU AID VOLUNTEERS - GETTING INVOLVED aims at facilitating the preparedness and response to humanitarian crises and limit the risks of disasters, creating opportunities to strengthening the capacity of hosting local organizations, with the support of the Eu Aid Volunteers.
OBJECTIVES	Strengthening the capacity of local organizations, and the process of needs and competence framework process, including New EU affiliated local organizations. Preparing and improving the preparation and local response of local organizations to humanitarian crises, in terms of disaster risk management and preparedness with the active participation of at least 200 local workers in the identified communities. Promoting and strengthening local volunteering capacities and values in third countries, increasing the quality and the number of people supporting in the humanitarian aid-based actions. Contribute to strengthen and build new potential partnerships in the third countries, and in particular with New EU13 affiliated local organizations, in order to develop joint projects within the EU Aid Volunteers initiative that support and complement humanitarian aid. Contribute to promote and spread the European Union's humanitarian aid principles agreed in the European Consensus on Humanitarian Aid and give visibility to the EU Aid V initiative. Ensuring a continuous and efficient coordination and monitoring of the implementation of activities and the fulfilment of action objectives throughout the duration of all the project, with the support of all the project partners.

ACTIVITIES

Implementation of 16 focus groups and 24 online consultations to create a need framework for local organizations and the evaluation of the foreseen need.

24 workshop and 5 study visits to increase the knowledge and the capacity of local organization are planned.

A global conference online between 40 European volunteers and 40 volunteers from third countries to allow an exchange and a virtual peer exchange.

24 laboratories in 4 third countries to develop the volunteerism spirit with the help of local and international volunteers .

A workshop in Budapest, based on the experience and the final evaluation of the pilot project, in order to capitalize on and disseminate the lessons learned and the volunteers curricula developed.

Drafting of a communication and dissemination plan to develop a series of tools and methodologies to disseminate the EU humanitarian aid perspective.
