DESCRIPTION	The project aimed to the farmers living in the Siem Reap province and to their families, guaranteeing their food security thanks to the distribution of seeds and improving of agricultura inputs.
OBJECTIVES	This project guaranteed the food security of rural populations, specifically those subject to the continuous price variations of food items, through an increase of productivity, improvement to agricultural services and inputs, and an increase and diversification of the food they eat.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strengthening of food production and the productivity of family businesses through the distribution of agricultural inputs; • Reduction of post-harvesting losses through supply of tools and storage units to at least 8,500 families involved in the project; • Improvement of family food consumption through the promotion of consumption diversification; • Increase of cultivated areas and cereal production through integrated water management, to the benefit of approximately 12,500 families.
