DESCRIPTION	The scarce accessibility to water resources in oPt severely affects the population of Sud and East West Bank. Palestinian Authority lack of control over the water resources prevents any solution to the water issue based on infrastructural development. This project aims to solve the problem of water shortage in the territory, allowing the population access to safe drinking water and a general improvement in sanitary conditions.
OBJECTIVES	Ensure water availability and access to the most vulnerable population in the South and East West Bank, thereby improving the general hygiene conditions and allowing sanitation access.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing drinkable water in 53 communities in South Hebron and Eastern Bethlehem. • Awareness campaign on water quality and on management and cleanliness of cisterns. • Improvement of the water storage through the construction of 5 steel tanks in South and East West Bank. • Improvement of the water transportation through the donation of 3 water trucks to vulnerable communities in South and East West Bank. • Improvement of the management aspect through capacity development and institutional building at local, regional and national levels. • Improvement of the technical support at local, regional and national levels.
