DESCRIPTION	Support to street children and adolescents through the activation of the "low threshold" method, based on adirect approach on the streets, and the creation of a network of public and private institutions that deal with the issue of street children (NNASC - Niños niñas y adolescentes en situacìon de calle).
OBJECTIVES	The project guaranteed that girls, boys, and adolescents fully benefit from their universal and specific rights, involving children and adolescents living on the streets and children and adolescents victims of sexual abuses.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The AANAC association reinforces its structure to become a reference point in the process of creation of support networks which involve stakeholders active in the support of children and adolescents who live on the streets; • The institutions are provided with a virtual platform which offers information and facilitates coordination on a national level in this sector; • Public and private institutions have an approach method oriented towards guaranteeing the fundamental rights of children and adolescents who live on the streets; • Public and private requests move within a network which allows for a more incisive impact on public policy.
