DESCRIPTION	The project addressed the problems related to the demolitions of water and sanitation facilities in different areas of the West Bank, imposed by Israel.
OBJECTIVES	The project focused on the restoration of water and sanitation facilities to improve the life conditions of the beneficiaries. The reconstruction of the demolished infrastructures allowed the population to benefit from their use but it has also represented a concrete support, in order for the population not to abandon the areas they lived in, because of the demolitions.
