<p>DESCRIPTION</p>	<p>The project involved 60 boys and girls living in precarious economic and social conditions, 200 members of cooperatives dealing with recycling of urban waste and 40 staff members of local administrations, bringing indirectly benefits to the 500,000 inhabitants of Santa Fe, by recovering, manage and treat the electronic waste, and by integrate into workforce the young boy and girls coming from the most vulnerable neighbourhoods.</p>
<p>OBJECTIVES</p>	<p>Recovering Future promoted the inclusion and integration into the workforce of youth from 18 to 25 years old in situations of economic and social vulnerability through professional training activities related to the recovery, management, and treatment of electronic waste, in order to reduce its environmental impact.</p>
<p>ACTIVITIES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training of youth at risk in the recycling of electronic waste materials, and their possible recovery and donation to community centers in the most vulnerable neighborhoods. • Accompaniment and integration of youth into the workforce. • Support to the creation of a social enterprise in the service sector based on the direct participation of able youth with support of the private sector. • Improvement of recycling techniques and legislation for the ecological treatment of electronic devices no longer in use.
