OBJECTIVES	This project improved the living conditions of the populations in rural areas in the western district of Haiti stricken by the earthquake, through improved access to water and basic health care, as well as reinforcement of the Water Security Plan.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rehabilitation/reconstruction of water access structures damaged by the earthquake; • Implementation of awareness campaigns about good practices in personal hygiene; • Rehabilitation of damaged public buildings and installation of drinking water structures; • Support of local associations and institutions in the promotion of a Water Security Plan; • Involvement, through the "cash for work" system, of local workers in the rehabilitation and reconstruction of water structures.
