IMPLEMENTATION PERIOD	6 months
DESCRIPTION	The initiative takes place in the post-war context that followed the Israeli military operation "Protective edge" in Gaza Strip that damaged the private and public infrastructures. The lack of access to clean drinking water, shortage of water for sanitation as well as major damages to sewage systems pose risk of water borne diseases and related health issues. The ongoing project is thus targeted to the restoration of the damaged water infrastructure and to guarantee the quality of water.
OBJECTIVES	The project aims to ensure the access to safe water for the population of the Middle Area of Gaza Strip through direct distribution of potable water and the rehabilitation of the water supply system for domestic use.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provision of 12.660 m3 of safe water for 2 months. • Water Laboratory analysis. • Rehabilitation of wells. • Provision and installation of 552 meters of pipes in Al Mughraqa and Deir Al Balah. • Provision and installation of an electrical 70KW generator in El Bureij.
