DESCRIPTION	The entire Palestinian population of the West Bank benefited from shorter waiting lists at hospitals and from increased resources for health services, thanks to a decrease in costs paid by the Palestinian Authority. .
OBJECTIVES	This project improved the health conditions of the Palestinian West Bank population through strengthening public hospitals, specifically through qualitative and quantitative improvement of diagnostic and therapeutic options in minimally invasive and laparoscopic surgery (both general and gynecological) in the public hospitals of Ramallah, Nablus, and Hebron.
