DESCRIPTION	The project improved the life conditions of the most isolated and vulnerable communities of the West Bank, thanks to the improvement of the access to water, to the basic sanitation services, raising the number of people with access to safe water and reducing those of people displaced because of the demolitions of the water and sanitation facilities.
OBJECTIVES	The project allowed the construction and the rehabilitation of reservoirs to collect rainwater in the rural communities hit in periods of drought, reinforcing the water network and raising awareness about basic hygienic practices.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction of reservoirs; • Reinforcing the water distribution network; • Rehabilitation of streets (to reduce time and cost for water transportation with the reservoirs); • Provision of water and sanitation facilities in the schools and center for people with disabilities; • Distribution of filters; • Provision of latrines.
