DESCRIPTION	The project targeted the poorest family members in participating rural areas (with particular attention to large families), farmers without land to cultivate, grassroots agricultural associations, local authorities, and the DEA (Department of Agricultural Extension).
OBJECTIVES	This project contributed to poverty reduction in the most vulnerable groups in 5 rural provinces, reinforcing the skills of the local population and authorities to favor agricultural development and the food security of the poorest families.
