DESCRIPTION	Thanks to the project vulnerable families with women and heads of household, whose members were in large part unemployed, disabled, or elderly benefited from food assistance through food and agricultural tool distribution (rice seeds, fertilizer, food items, animals for breeding) so that agricultural and breeding activities could start up again and from reconstruction and rehabilitation activities involving destroyed buildings and agricultural structures (houses, warehouses, water infrastructure).
OBJECTIVES	In response to the passing of typhoon Ketsana through central Vietnam, GVC focused its intervention in the province of Thua Thien Hue, implementing post-emergency activities centered on recovery of pre-typhoon living conditions and economic activities within rural communities through the reconstruction of water network infrastructure, supply of materials, seed, animal, tool and other resource distribution in order to allow agricultural and herding activities to start up again.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distribution of supplies and assistance for the reconstruction and restructuring of houses; • Distribution of construction materials for the reconstruction of warehouses and other structures used in livestock raising; • Distribution of seedlings, animals, and other agricultural inputs to reactivate their income generating activities; • Support in the reconstruction of water networks for aquaculture, and dams/canals for the irrigation of rice fields.
