OBJECTIVES	This project reinforced the rights of indigenous populations that reside in urban areas to basic service (health care, education, culture, and professional training), supporting the social, political, and cultural self-determination skills of the indigenous population in the Metropolitan Region of Belo Horizonte through a process of dialogue with the surrounding urban society.
