DESCRIPTION	The project improved the management of water cycles capabilities of the local communities of the municipalities of Chulumani, Irupana, and La Asunta.
OBJECTIVES	The EPSAs (Potable Water and Sanitation Service Providers), legally constituted and recognized by the populations in the Chulumani, Irupana, and La Asunta municipalities, are able to carry out the technical and administrative management of water and wastewater cycles, with the help of training courses. The population of the Sud Yungas province is more aware of the issues of environmental protection and can ask for greater governmental investment in basic reclamation and the preservation of water resources.
