DESCRIPTION	Thanks to the 2012-2013 "Winterization" programme, 3000 blankets and 480 heaters have been distributed, and 723 families received fuel between January and March 2013.
OBJECTIVES	Guarantee to Syrian and hosting families the access to basic services (Shelter and WASH) and to essential goods.
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emergency winterization for rooms and tents; • Distribution of blankets and stoves to cook and to heat; • Fuel distribution (through vouchers); • Improving the water distribution system; • Distribution of WASH items (hygienic kits, filters, water tanks and emergency latrines); • Improving the sanitary structures in 2 schools and awareness raising campaign on hygiene on a community level; • At the end of the project, the following items have been distributed: 5472 mattresses, 7680 blankets, 1523 kitchen sets, 1409 dignity kits of which 130 by UNICEF, 614 baby kits of which 38 by UNICEF.
